

ONWASA REPORT

BOARD OF ALDERMAN MEETING

9/2/10

At the ONWASA meetings of 8/19/10 the following actions were taken. Complete board agendas and packets can be view at the ONWASA web site.

1. The ONWASA board of directors approved: purchasing broad band radios; a contract for generator maintenance and repair; a contract to purchase chemicals; and increasing the amount budgeted for a rate study
2. ONWASA staff member Eileen Navarette P.E. gave a presentation on the Swansboro Reclaimed Water Feasibility Study.
3. The board approved moving ahead with the scope of work for Stump Sound Wastewater Improvements to include keeping the Holly Ridge plant on line and tying it into the Summerhouse Reclamation facility.
4. The ONWASA board approved a budget increase for upsizing the sewer force main from Ellis Airport to the treatment plant. The upsizing allows will potentially allow ONWASA to add more customers to that line.
5. The board of directors approved submitting a funding application to the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund for a reverse osmosis membrane project at the Dixon water plant. The board also approved \$370,000 to perform a pilot study, design, and bidding services related to the project.
