

**Topsail Island Shoreline Protection Commission
September 2010 Report**

The TISPC met for the regular meeting at the Surf City Town Hall on August 24th at 2:00 p.m.

Chairman Curley read highlights from the Marlowe and Company bulletin.

There was discussion on Strategic Planning, but no action was taken as nobody was there to represent Topsail Beach.

An update was given on the NTB project, that the Town has received its CAMA permit and that the Town is in the process of doing a citizen survey.

There was discussion about the trip to D.C. for the Surf City/NTB Federal project presentation before the Civil Works Review Board on Friday, August 27th.

There will be discussion at the next meeting in regards to the objectives and scheduling of the commission's meetings. There was some preliminary discussion on changing the date and/or time of the meetings to accommodate everyone on the commission.

There was extensive discussion in regards to the proposed expansion of the Inlet Hazard Zone. Nobody on the commission seemed to be in favor of it and the basic feeling is that there is no positive outcome and many unintended consequences if it is to be enacted.
